3 Matters Arising

4 Our Venue- David G7URP

As the school has now become an Academy, the new management, with David had a meeting at the school re the current arrangement with the hosting of the NARC club meetings. There is a current menu of prices for various rooms, including the rooms used by NARC. David asked for and was agreed that we should receive 50% off these rates. The main common room (£16ph) will cost us £8 per hour, so £24 per 3 hour club meeting. For hire of the extra classroom (£6 per hour) but as additional hire to the main room only £3 per hour, as the Radio shack /computer room is a thoroughfare we get this at no charge.

Start date of the 1st April was requested by the school.

All agreed to book Main common room (3hrs) plus the additional classroom (2hrs) for the year at £30.00 per meeting eveneing. David to submit the relevant paperwork along with a copy of the contract NARC have with the previous co-ordinator Dave Brodie. And allow them to decide start date as our contract says one term notice for any changes charges.

All committee feel this is a small price to pay considering all the facility benefits we receive.

5 Club Logo - Roger G3LDI

Roger thought the NACR logo looked drab next to other sponsors on DXpeditions websites we have supported and asked about changing it. When the brand was discussed, regarding all the apparel that would be obsolete, it was decided to redo the logo file we submit to include the website strap line to be included with the main logo, as this was missing online.

6 Access to Membership list on dropbox - Malcolm G3PDH

Discussion ensued on why committee members couldn't access the Membership database on dropbox due to a new password.

Because of un-planned amends being done by persons unknown, Chris GOTZZ applied a password to prevent this in the future. Mark to make file read only and only available to committee members, for looking up specific information. Due to data protection issues, in future committee members should, if asked for contact details of person X by person Y. They should take person Y's details and pass to person X to contact them, NOT just give out person X's details. Alternatively contact the membership secretary and he will do it.

Future dropbox Membership list in PDF read only format to only show Call sign, Name, email & telephone number.
