5) CLUB LOG Issues - 2E0TWQ league standings

6) International Marconi Day - Steve G0KYA

Steve G0KYA advises that the date this year is the 27th of April, he will organise the event and coordinate the rota. He has emailed Zane and the venue is all agreed. This year it was suggested to use an amp to increase contact levels at this low sunspot part of the cycle.

7) Provisional overview of NFD and RadioActive June G3PDH

In principle the event will go ahead as previously, John G3XLL has asked to return with his display and asked if it was possible to use David's cabin on site. This needs a new floor and it was agreed that NARC would provide both suitable chipboard flooring and also assist in its fitting before the event in June.
